### 1. Introduction and contents

1.1 The Civil Aviation Authority of Fiji hosted the 51<sup>st</sup> ISASI Reachout

Reachout 51 was opened on Monday, November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2016 by the Chief Executive Officer of CAAF Mr. Netava Waqa.
